

## Review of years 9-12 - Submission

**Site:** Newstead College (Year 11/12 Public College), Launceston

**Size:** Approx. 750 students

**VET RTO:** Tasmanian Secondary Colleges RTO

**Number and range of VET qualifications:** Currently delivering 10 VET qualifications

**Current VET enrolments:** 130

Newstead College has a proud tradition of supporting students in year 11 and 12 who are on a VET pathway. We have outstanding educational facilities available on site that cater for 9 Certificate II Qualifications and 1 Certificate I Pathway Qual (see attachment with current offerings)

Other key points of the VET educational pathway at Newstead College include:

- Authentic 'simulated' work environments including: a fully functional Café and Restaurant (Café Cypress), Hair Salon (Salon on Cypress), Furniture and Construction workshops and Child Care/Playgroup facilities.
- Approx. 200 Workplaces in the Greater Launceston Area on our database that take each of our VET students for work placement 'in industry' for 4 lots of 1 week work placements throughout the year.
- The opportunity to gain VET qualifications that also contribute points towards gaining the TCE at the same time as gaining an ATAR score for University entrance.
- A high number of our students gain direct employment and/or Apprenticeships in their chosen VET pathway after leaving college.
- All VET staff are required to consult with their relevant industry on numerous occasions through the year to ensure that our qualifications remain 'current' this includes: industry validation of training and assessment, workplace visits, unit planning.

In summary, having personally worked in a high school for 13 years prior to teaching at Newstead College and now having worked in a college for the past 4 years I cannot recommend strongly enough the need for these VET pathways to continue to provide our young people with authentic, hands on and industry relevant skills and qualifications that will lead them to a pathway of success.
