# ACER Applied Reading Test

## Second Edition General/Clerical

The ACER Applied Reading Test Second Edition (ART-2) is a quick and easily administered test of adult literacy. It is suitable for recruitment selection into administrative, trades or operational positions; assessing the literacy of adults with a non-English speaking background; and testing for entry into TAFE or further education courses. ART-2 can also be used to assess the reading comprehension of those returning to work or study after rehabilitation or long-term unemployment, as well as of those with disabilities or medical conditions.

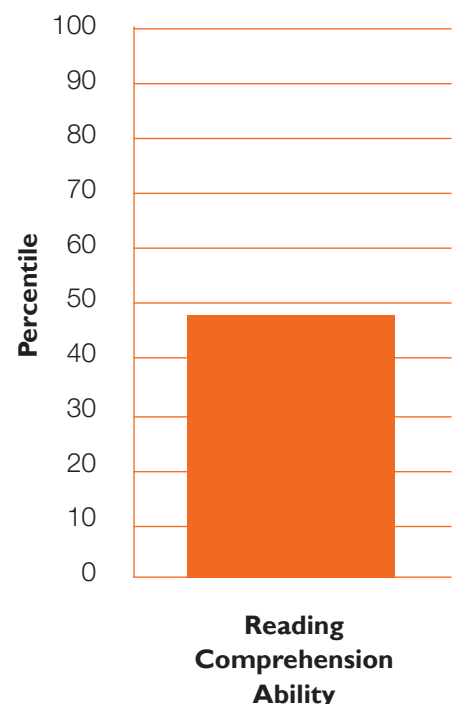
The test contains information commonly found in the workplace and is presented in a variety of formats. ART-2 is free of technical jargon or text that depends on previous training or knowledge.

This ensures its relevance in various workplace contexts, as well as its validity in assessing a candidate's ability to interpret written material presented in various formats, regardless of their background.

The General/Clerical test targets those aiming for entry into general administration courses or roles. It contains passages of text in a variety of formats. These include: signs, instructions for operating office equipment, emails, employee information, brief legal notes, etc. These texts may be presented in the form of tables, diagrams, pictures and text to approximate the look and tone of written material that is typically seen in an office environment.
