Which word does NOT go with the other four?

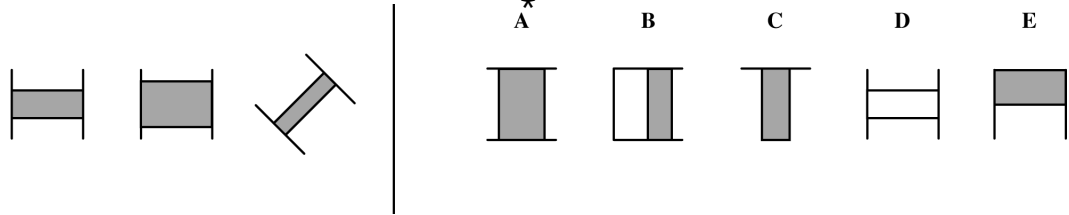
